Hairstyle


Students are expected to keep their hair looking natural, clean and well groomed.

As our students continue to work in their various classes from home through our Google Classroom platform, our parents are required to provide the following at home:

- ◆ Provision of a personal computer or access to your smart device.
- ◆ Provision of internet facility (data or WIFI).
- ◆ Strict monitoring of your child's online engagement.
- ◆ Create daily study sessions to fit their schedule.
- ◆ Help them manage their time independently.
- ◆ Track and monitor their progress.

Assignments

Parents are advised to closely monitor or supervise their children to make sure that all given assignments are thoroughly done. Failure to do any assignment is taken seriously.

School Uniform

Pupils /Students are expected to always be in neat/clean/ironed uniforms; all torn uniforms and lost buttons are to be replaced and repaired respectively.
